Liability Form This document will provide you with all of the instructions you need to ensure that you will have a great visit to the mine. **Please read it carefully, and be sure to complete the release of liability form before you arrive.** You will need to complete **ONE copy of the form for each GROUP** that attends the dig, and parents will need to complete it on behalf of their children. No form required if you have already completed a form in the last 365 days.

Our Facilities We provide a large shaded pavilion with a water mist cooling system and picnic tables. There is a gas grill that can be used by our guests on a first come, first served basis, and faucets for water and/or washing up after the dig. There are very nice modern bathroom facilities on site as well. The dig is off of a dirt road. While you do not need a 4WD vehicle, you should also not bring a car with low clearance, such as a sports car.

What does the dig include? We provide everything you need for an enjoyable and successful gem dig. You will have a table with buckets, screens to sort your gravel, water to wash the gravel, and of course lots of rich muck from the mines. Each table also has brushes for scrubbing your specimens and trowels to help you sort and screen your gravel. In addition to the fee dig, we provide a tour of Chief Mountain on our 4WD buggies. You don't need anything for the ride—just be ready when it's your turn. You'll see multiple mine tunnels, and get spectacular views of the San Luis Rey Valley and nearby mines such as the Tourmaline Queen and Stewart Mines.

What should you bring? Completed Liability Form, Cash for Admission. Please bring plenty of water and any food that you will want. **If it is HOT we do rent optional SHADE UMBRELLAS.** You can also bring something for shade; a POP-UP canopy or beach umbrella works well but please bring some rope or tie downs to secure your shade as it can be windy on the top of Chief Mountain. You should bring either small plastic containers or ziplock baggies for finds.

How should we dress? You should wear regular shoes—no sandals, please be prepared to get dirty, so you might want to bring a change of clothes; you can change in the bathrooms when you're done digging. We strongly recommend that you use ample sunscreen and bring a hat and sunglasses. To protect your hands from sharp rocks and the water, we strongly recommend that you bring gloves. The best gloves are either dishwashing gloves or rubber coated gardening gloves. These will give you a good grip and yet protect your hands.

What time do you start? Please be prompt - **Arrival time is 9:30am.** **Dig ends 4 hours after start.** As a result, it's very important that you show up on time so that we aren't delayed. This will give you time to pay and get set up at your table before the orientation. If you are late, you may be forced to wait to dig while we make sure those who have showed up on time get their orientation.

Can I bring my pet? No, unfortunately due to liability issues we can't allow pets. If you require a service animal, please use the "Contact Us" form to email us and we can work with you to accommodate this.

Directions and Map? For detailed directions please go to <https://digforgems.com/map/> Use Google Maps to our Entrance located at: <https://bit.ly/ovmroute> there is a sign out along the road. Pull in and head up the road; you will be met by one of the dig hosts to collect your fee and papers. The orange groves you travel through are private property. Please do not stop and pick fruit—respect our neighbors. Support the local farmers and buy from them.

Weather and Cancellations? Please make sure you have a valid reservation receipt. We have a reminder system that uses emails and text messages to get a hold of you. In the event of inclement weather we might cancel or provide you needed information for the day. If you need to cancel for any reason please use the cancellation system on the website so we can fill your vacant spot(s). **Please do not NO-SHOW us.** We have a regular staff that we employ and there are others that might want your spot. No shows may get you on the do not dig list. Please don't take a chance.

Do I have to pay for gems that I find? NO that's the wonderful thing--you can keep anything you find. We've had people find gems worth many of thousands of dollars on the pile, and all it costs you is the base fee for the dig.

What does the dig cost? The dig fee is \$75 for adults and children aged 12 and up. Children aged (5-11 years are \$60; children aged 4 and under are free, but must be with an adult at all times. We have a family four-pack discount for two adults and two children between (5-11 years) the fee is \$240. **Please bring the proper amount in CASH to the gate.**
